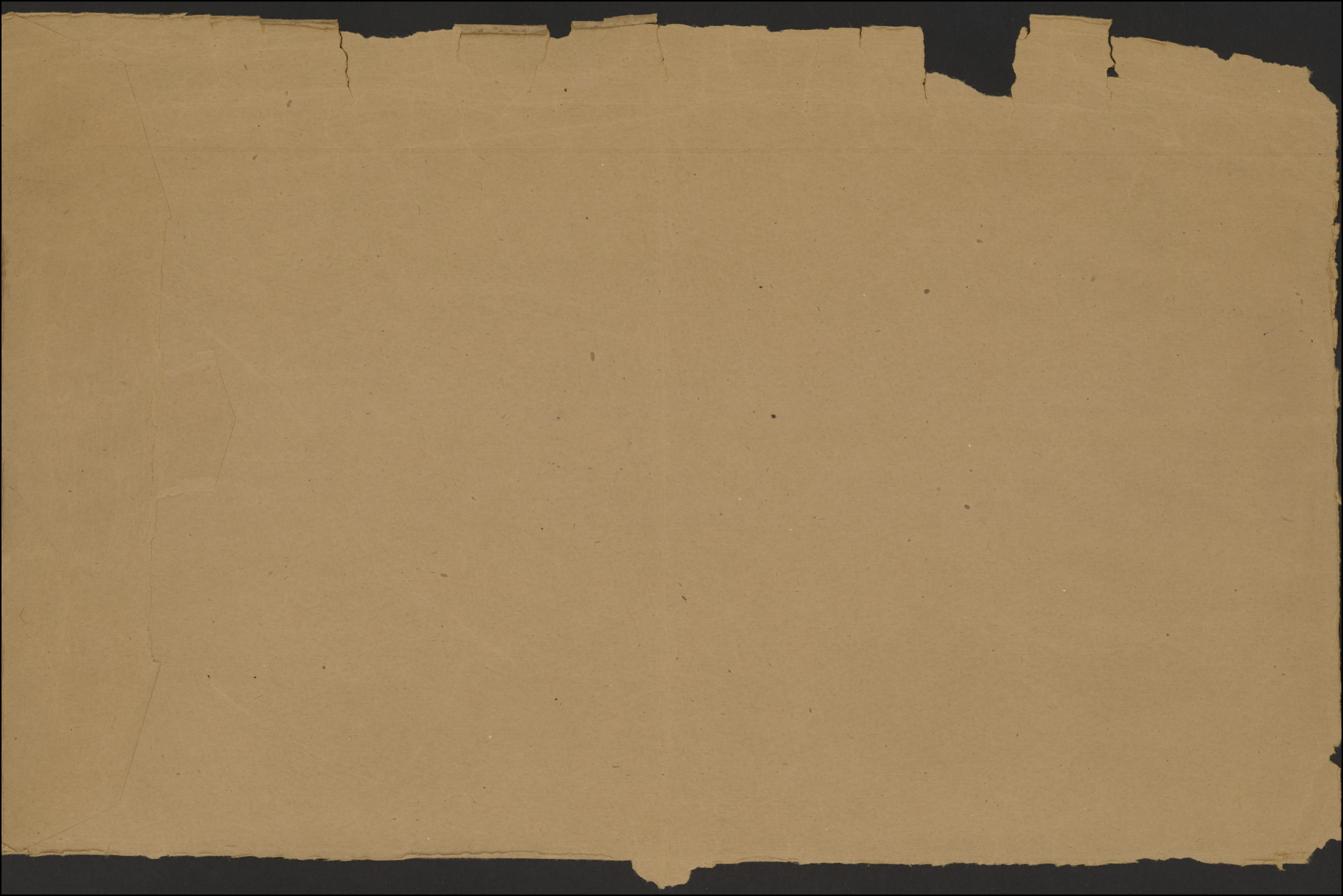

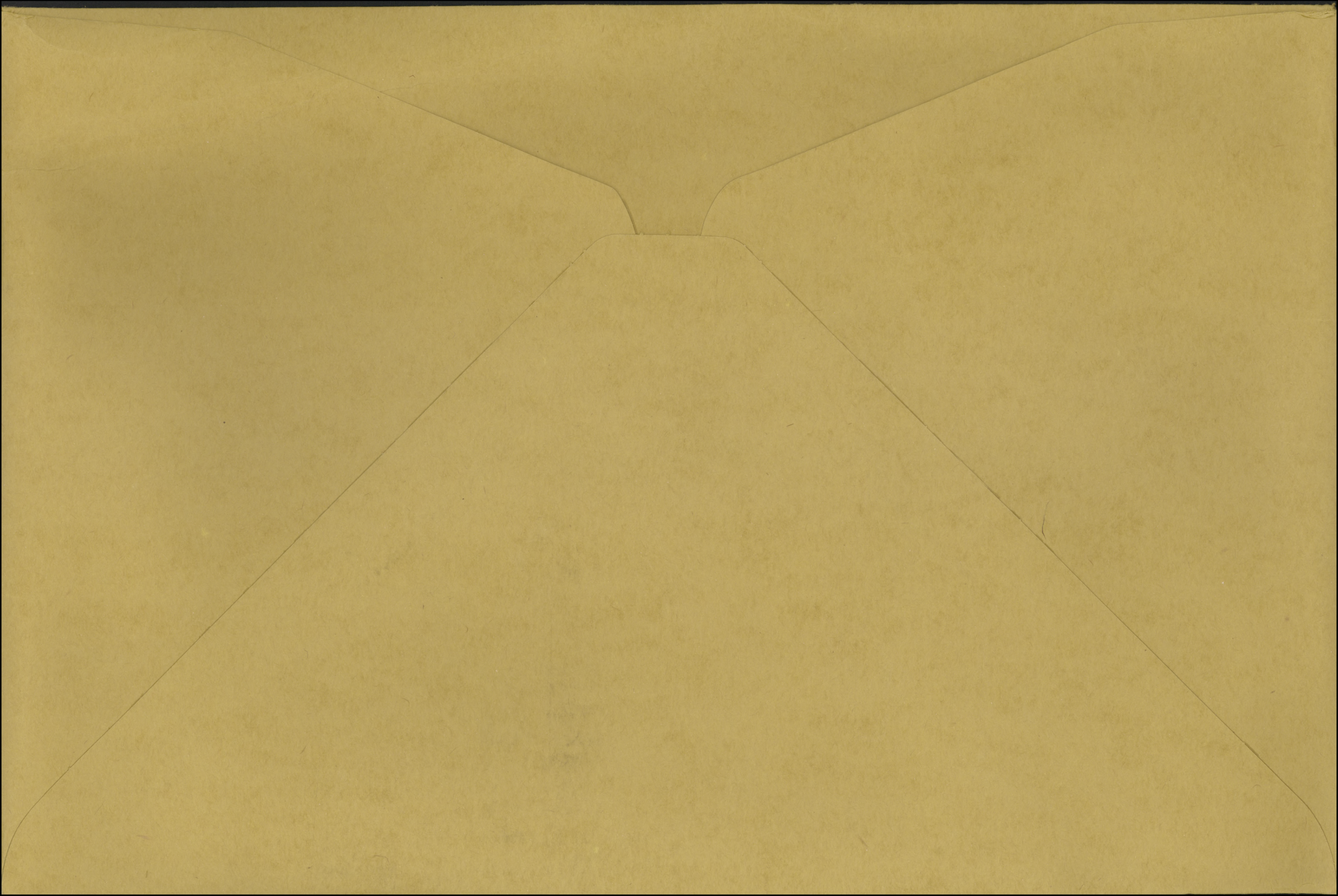

On July 22. patient cut his finger but did not consider injury serious. About two days later the cut became sore and pus appeared. The condition became worse and the patient who was in London on leave consulted a civilian surgeon. The latter treated him once but the patient upon attempting to leave London to rejoin his unit was arrested by the military authorities for overstaying leave. He was under detention for three days during which time he received no medical attention. On July 28 he was escorted back to his lines and on July 29th admitted to hospital.

Examination showed patient appearing very ill and with a high temperature. On the dorsum of the thumb of the left hand, prox. phalanx, there was a discharging sinus. ~~Just~~ just over the corresponding metacarpal there was an abscess. Redness extended half-way to the elbow and there was pain ~~in~~ the axilla.
