We called a boy in a row-boat to help but his boat was between McRobie and the drowning man and delayed the former. Cann was in the water about three or four minutes before he disappeared. We then got grapnel hooks and got him out about ten minutes after he sank. We brought him ashore and worked over him for over an hour without results. I recognize the body as that of L/C. Cann.

We each got in a canoe and went after Sgt. Rogers and Pte. Howard and Pte. Porter who were in a motor boat. I tied my canoe to the motor boat and jumped in and Cann tied his to the back of mine. As he turned around the canoe turned over and he fell in the water. We called out to know ~~xxx~~ if he could swim and he didn't answer so I jumped in. A boy and girl in a row-boat got in the way and before I could get around to the other side Cann had disappeared and did not come up again. I then came ashore. I recognize the body as that of L/C. Cann.

again, but he did not appear. A further delay of about five minutes took place before we could get a boat and some grapnels. In about five minutes after starting to use the grapnel hook we got him to the surface. He was lifted into a boat that I got and I rowed him ashore. Pte. Howard and myself worked over him using artificial respiration, turning him on his face and using pressure over his sides from behind. I also pulled his tongue out. A doctor was telephoned for and he came in about ten minutes time. He gave a hypodermic injection and afterwards the deceased was rolled on a barrell. All this time artificial respiration was kept up, and hot water bottles applied. This was kept up for an hour or possibly longer without result. The body was then removed to the Khaki Country Club, a short distance from the wharf where the body was brought ashore. About fifteen minutes before efforts to resuscitate him were given up, his clothes were removed, and hot blankets applied. I recognize the body as that of the deceased, L/C. Cann.

I knew the deceased Lance-Corporal Cann for about a week. I was out in a motor boat shortly after dinner on the after-noon of September eleventh with three others, Sgt. Rogers, Pte. Porter and Gnr McRobie. Gnr McRobie had just got into our Motor-boat from his canoe, L/C. Cann came along in his canoe and tied his canoe onto the one Gnr. McRobie had been in. I heard a splash and looked around and saw L/C. Cann struggling in the water. McRobie's canoe which had been tied to the motor-boat in which I was became separated from the motor-boat and the two canoes tied together drifted away. I shouted to a little boy and girl in a row-boat about thirty yards distant to row over to Cann to give him assistance and at the same time Gnr McRobie jumped overboard to rescue him. The row-boat got between them and delayed McRobie's progress and before he could get to the drowning man the latter had disappeared. He was under water about ten minutes before we could get his body which we brought ashore.

I personally knew the deceased Lance Corporal Cann, who was a patient at the Ste Anne-de Bellevue Hospital, on the afternoon of the eleventh September at a quarter past one o'clock the deceased went out in a canoe at Chateauguay Basin where he had been staying since Monday the eighth instant, following a motor boat. Gunner McRobie who was in another canoe, got into the motor boat while it was in motion and tied his canoe to the motor-boat. L/C. Cann then tied his canoe to that of Gunner McRobie to save paddling. He then stood up and walked back to the other end of the canoe and put his hand on its side as he turned around. The canoe at once turned over and threw L/C. Cann into the water. I was in a motor-boat not far distant and saw all this myself.

As soon as it was seen that he could not swim, Gnr. McRobie the only one present who could swim dived in after him. A row boat with a little boy and girl came up, rowed in between McRobie and the drowning man, thinking that they might save him but the little girl cried so loudly the boy became excited and sheered his boat aside. L/C. Cann struggled for about four minutes and before McRobie could reach the spot Cann disappeared. Gnr. McRobie then hung on to the sides of the row-boat waiting for him to rise
