CONDITION ON ADMISSION AND PROGRESS OF CASE In August 1917, man was struck in the right chest, angle of scapula with a piece of shrapnel, which penetrated the wall and entered the chest. He then complained of pain in the right side, cough and dyspnea. States that he had no operations, and no fluid was withdrawn from chest. He now complains of pain in the right chest, laterally and anteriorly, with slight cough. No night sweats. He has marked dyspnea on exertion and feels extremely weak. Since returning to Canada he has been very nervous, and feels faint on being tired or excited. States he has always been healthy, and has never had pleurisy or other chest disease.

Man is fairly well nourished, pulse is regular, and of small volume, and easily compressible

Lungs: scar one inch in diameter at angle of right scapula. The breath sounds over the right base at angle of scapula are moderately roughened and there is slight increase in vocal resonance, no increase in dullness.
