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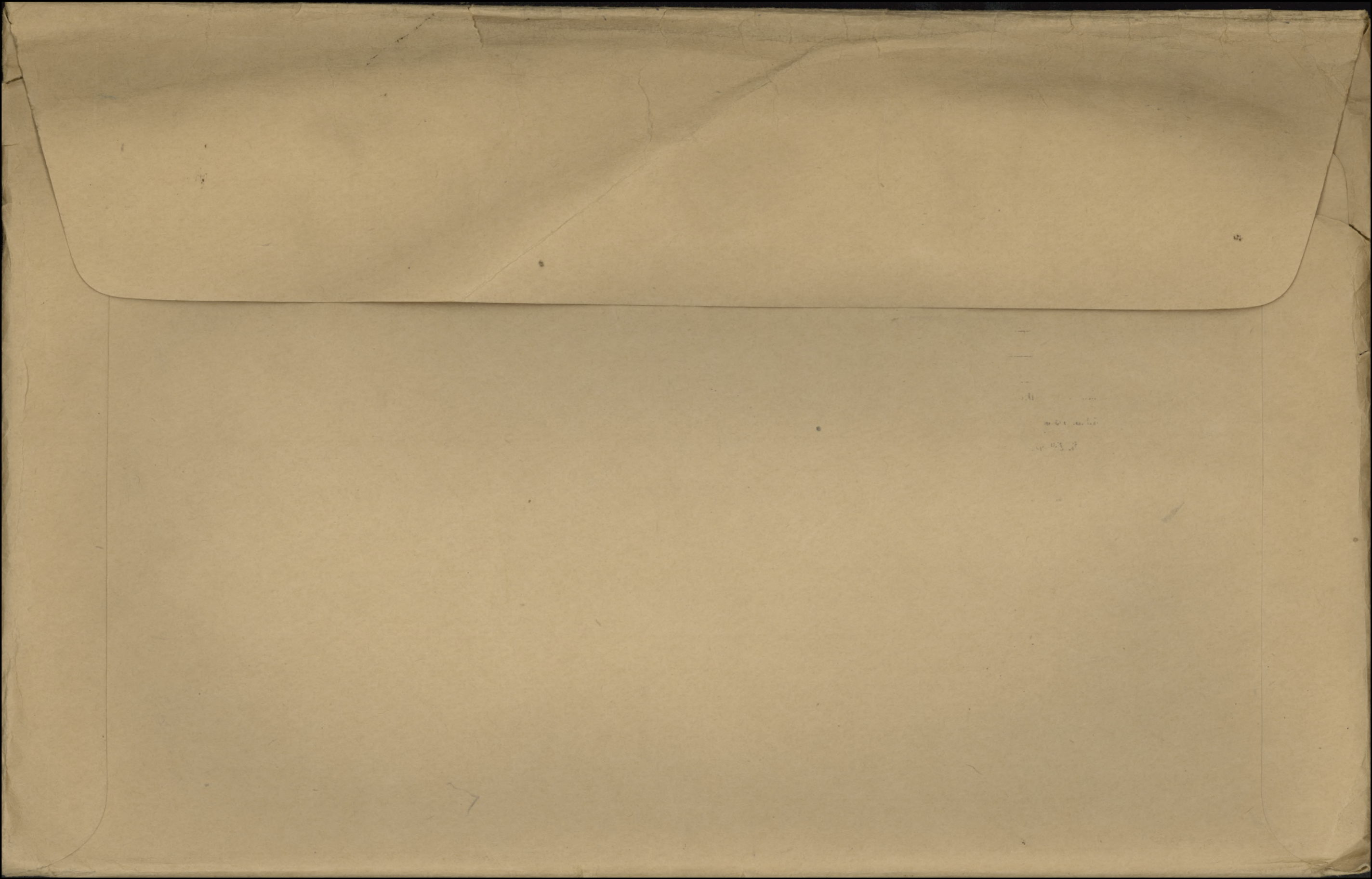

Diagnosis GSW. Left Hand. *Acute Nephritis* Place of origin Amiens.

CONDITION ON ADMISSION AND PROGRESS OF CASE. GSW. left hand. Point of entry indicated by scar near base of 3rd. metacarpal on dorsum of hand. Exit directly opposite. Movements of wrist, dorsi flexion 5°, Plantar flexion 10°, Eversion and Inversion - nil. Movements of fingers markedly limited - Index and Thumb 5° movements, middle ring and little fingers flexion 20°.

July 9/19: Man has complained that for the last few days he has felt rather sleepy and has had considerable headaches. On July 8/19 he was returned to hospital in a rather semi-comatose condition and during the night had seven seizures and one the following day. The convulsions began by twitching of the eyelids and the left arm and gradually spread to the rest of the body. The clonic spasm lasted about 2-5 minutes, and then there was a tremor of the body lasting from 10 to 15 minutes. Exam. of urine showed a trace of albumen but no casts. B.P. systolic 175 Diastolic 80.

The Board, having assembled pursuant to order, proceed to inquire into the cause of death of Private Dufty, Robert V. No. 726130, and find that—

(1) Man was admitted to Hospital May 12th, 1919, suffering from G.S.W. left hand, While under observation a trace of albumen was noted in the urine and some swelling under the eyes.

On July 8th, 1919, man was brought into Hospital about 4 p.m. in a rather comatose condition. During the night he had six (6) convulsions and one on the following day. The coma gradually deepened and the man died at 9 a.m. July 10th, 1919.

P.M. findings shows an increase of fluid in the brain with congestion of the veins. Kidneys showed a marked congestion with some small petechial haemorrhages beneath capsule areas, and the stomach showed signs of acute hyperemia. Diagnosis uremic poisoning.

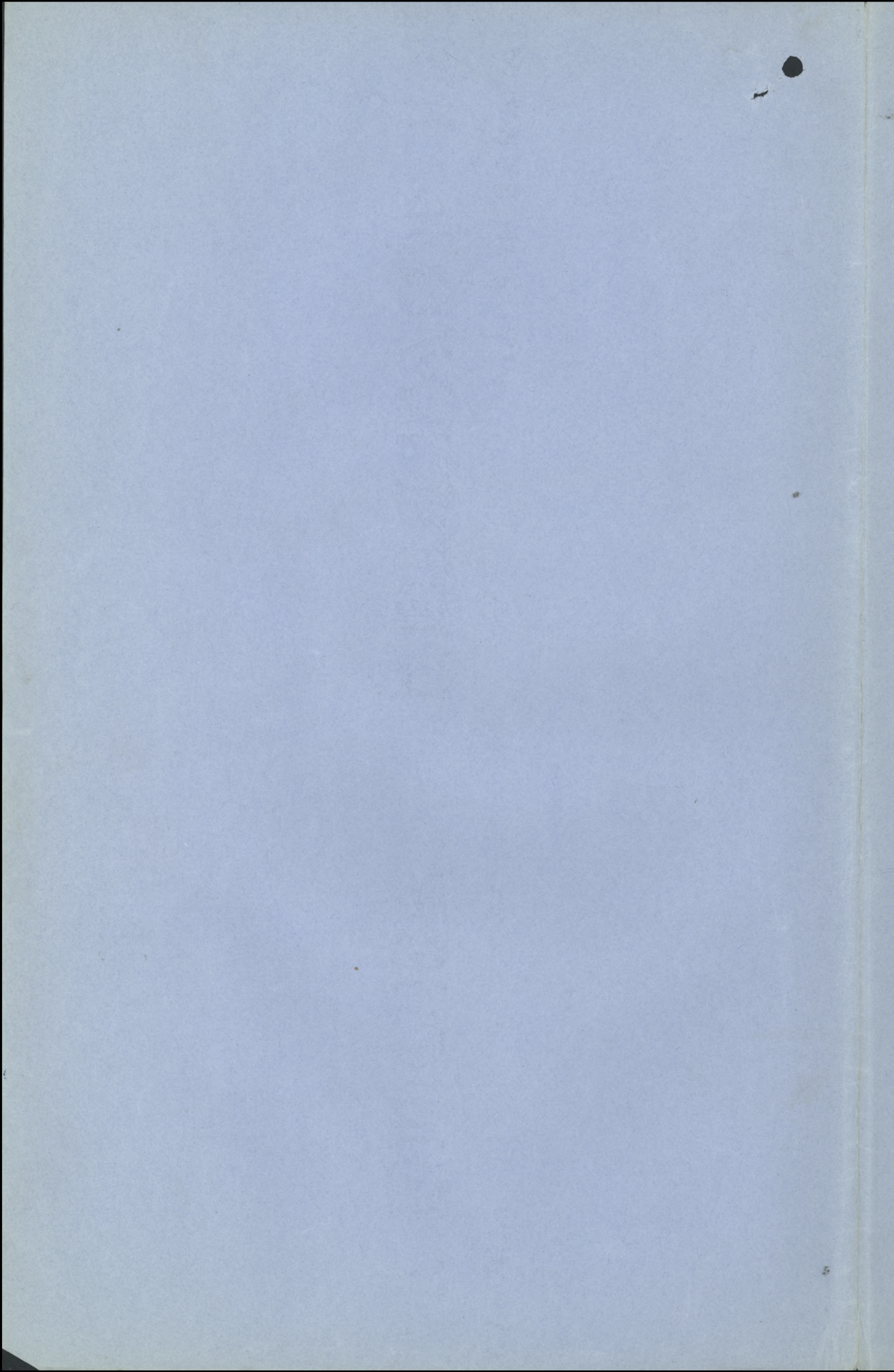

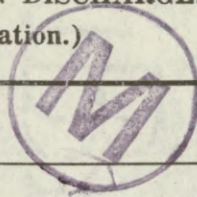
