Dispersal Area *2. I*

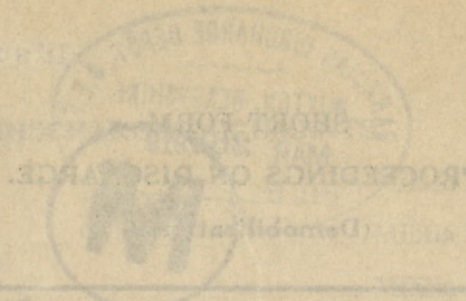
