Pat. was in a very bad condition. There was a laceration of the rectum & the pelvic colon was filled with blood clot. As low a colostomy as possible was rapidly performed & the laceration was packed as tightly as possible through the anus.

In spite of saline & stimulants pat. died at 10 pm. although there was no further haemorrhage after operation.
