THE HISTORY OF THE

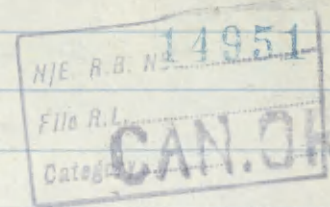
