- If space provided under any section is insufficient add another sheet. Such sheets must be initialed by the Medical Board.
- A note will be made of attached papers by the Medical Board under the section "Opinion of Medical Board."
- Under no circumstances may information other than that in sections 7, 8, 9 and 10 be communicated to the invalid, directly or indirectly.
- The nomenclature of diseases must be followed, if possible, as described in "List of Diseases" printed in the order in which they appear in the Annual Report on the Health of the Army, published in London (1915), by Messrs. Harrison & Sons.

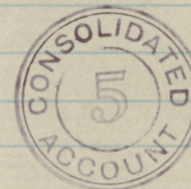
