Pulse - sitting at rest varies a good deal and is rapid - up to 125. The left half of chest is deformed - a pigeon chest. There is some clubbing of fingers.

Always robust - he played hockey and worked as a carpenter prior to enlisting and knew of no disability. He had measles when a boy, and age 14 was in bed 3 mos. & I.C.T. thigh (right) and abscess formation. Otherwise no illness. Stood 10 mos. infantry training quite well. To France 5/10/16, to 21 Bn. He did full duty and felt well for 2 1/2 mos. 3/1/17 to 8/1/17 were spent at Corps Rest station in France with "myalgia back & legs" (M.H.S.), and 15/2/17 to 15/3/17 in different hospitals in France with "Rheumatic fever" (M.H.S.). By his description he had a typical attack, and he dates his present disability from that illness. He says that thru summer of 1917 present symptoms were gradually getting worse. He did full duty until Dec 1917 when he came before a board and was categorized BII (Pay book). Since then he has really not done any work. He was tried out with Messy Corps in Jan, but could not stick it more than 2 weeks - and in Apr he was put to work as a water patrol. He stopped 6 or 7 weeks & was evacuated sick. 13/6/18 he came to Bermuda military hospital and 28/7/18 to Bushy Park. He complains of being easily exhausted, and of dyspnoea, palpitation, and vertigo, on exertion.
