STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE

In the case of accidental wounding of No. 724742 Pte. W.E.King of the 124th G.G.B.G. (Pioneers) Canadians.

No. 769980 Pte. G.Blackman, (Stretcher-bearer) 124th G.G.B.G. (Pioneers) being duly sworn gives evidence as follows:-

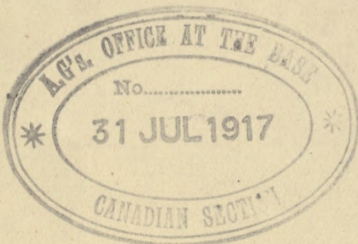
"About 11.30 p.m. on June 17th when on working Party, wiring in front of Support Trench, the enemy commenced to Shell. Every man in the party immediately made for the trench to take cover. The 72nd Canadian Infantry Battalion were Standing to in the Support with fixed Bayonets, and in jumping into the trench, No. 724742 Pte. W.E.King stumbled and impaled his left arm on a fixed bayonet, which was standing in the trench. I am unable to state who the ~~sw~~ owner of the Rifle and Bayonet was. I dressed the wound and had Private King proceed to Dressing Station.

No. 726009 Pte. E.W. Alexander, 124th G.G.B.G. (Pioneers) being duly sworn gives evidence as follows:-

"I was in front of No. 724742 Pte. W.E.King while wiring in front of Support line on the night of June 17-18th, and when the enemy commenced to shell we made for cover in the Trench, where the 72nd Battalion were "Standing To" with fixed bayonets. At the spot where Private King, jumped a rubber sheet ~~xxxx~~ had been stretched by a 72nd man to act as a sleeping shelter, and in the darkness, King apparently mistook this sheet for part of the parapet, causing him to fall into the trench with arms out-stretched his left arm being impaled on a fixed bayonet standing against the rubber sheet at side of trench. I assisted the dressing of the wound, and accompanied Private King to the Dressing Station,
