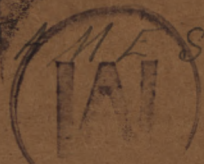

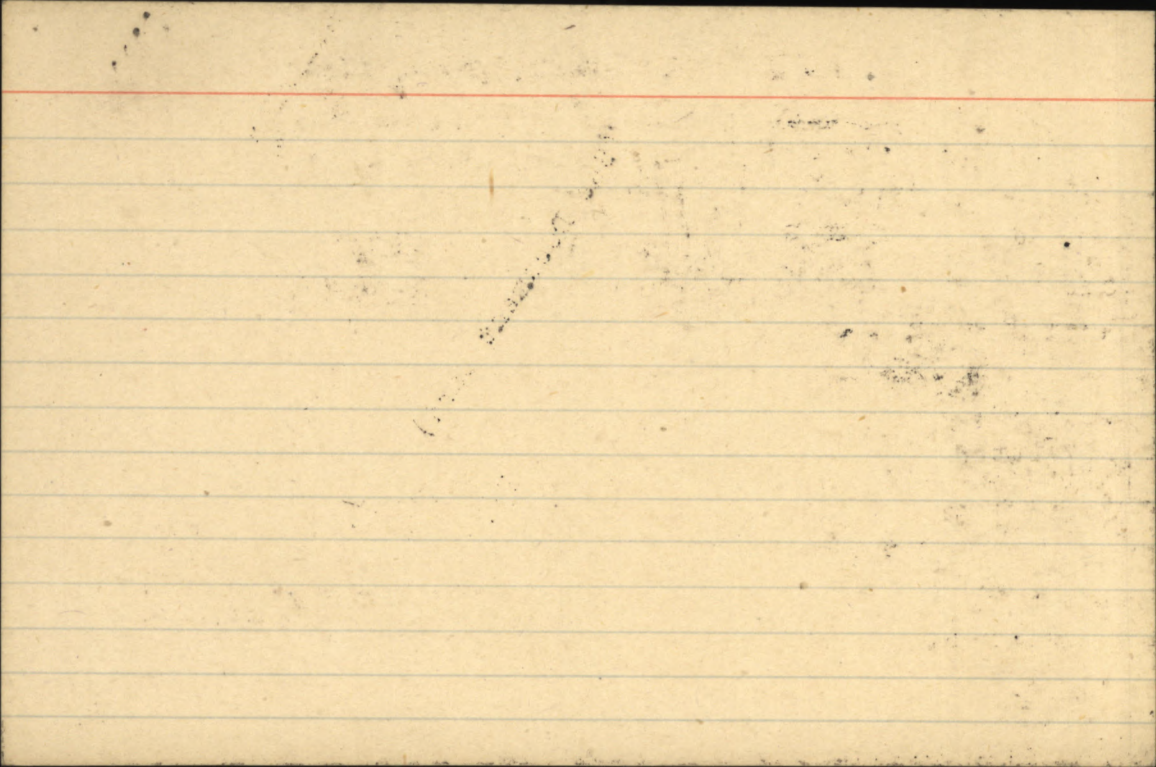

Age 48 as stated today. Gave on enlistment 38.

Present Complaint.

1. Cough mostly evenings with two or three ounces white sputum daily.
2. Dyspnea on walking a block at ordinary pace.
3. Takes cold easily when chest feels "stuffed".

No history of haemoptysis. Family history negative. Has been subject to winter cough for some years. Was in hospital at Bramshott 28/1/17 to 14/2/17 with Influenza. No other entries on M.H.S. Shorncliffe Board diagnosis ~~Mya~~ Myalgia and Chronic Bronchitis and reports lungs slightly emphysematous with prolonged expiration over both lungs but no rales.

Objective Examination:- Few scattered medium pitched rhonchi heard over both lungs. No change on precussion. Breath sounds normal.

Respirations:- 20 sitting and standing, 30 after ascending 24 steps, returning to 18 in 2½ minutes.

Diagnosis:- Chronic Bronchitis

Recommendation: Discharge 40% disability one quarter of which is due to aggravation from service.

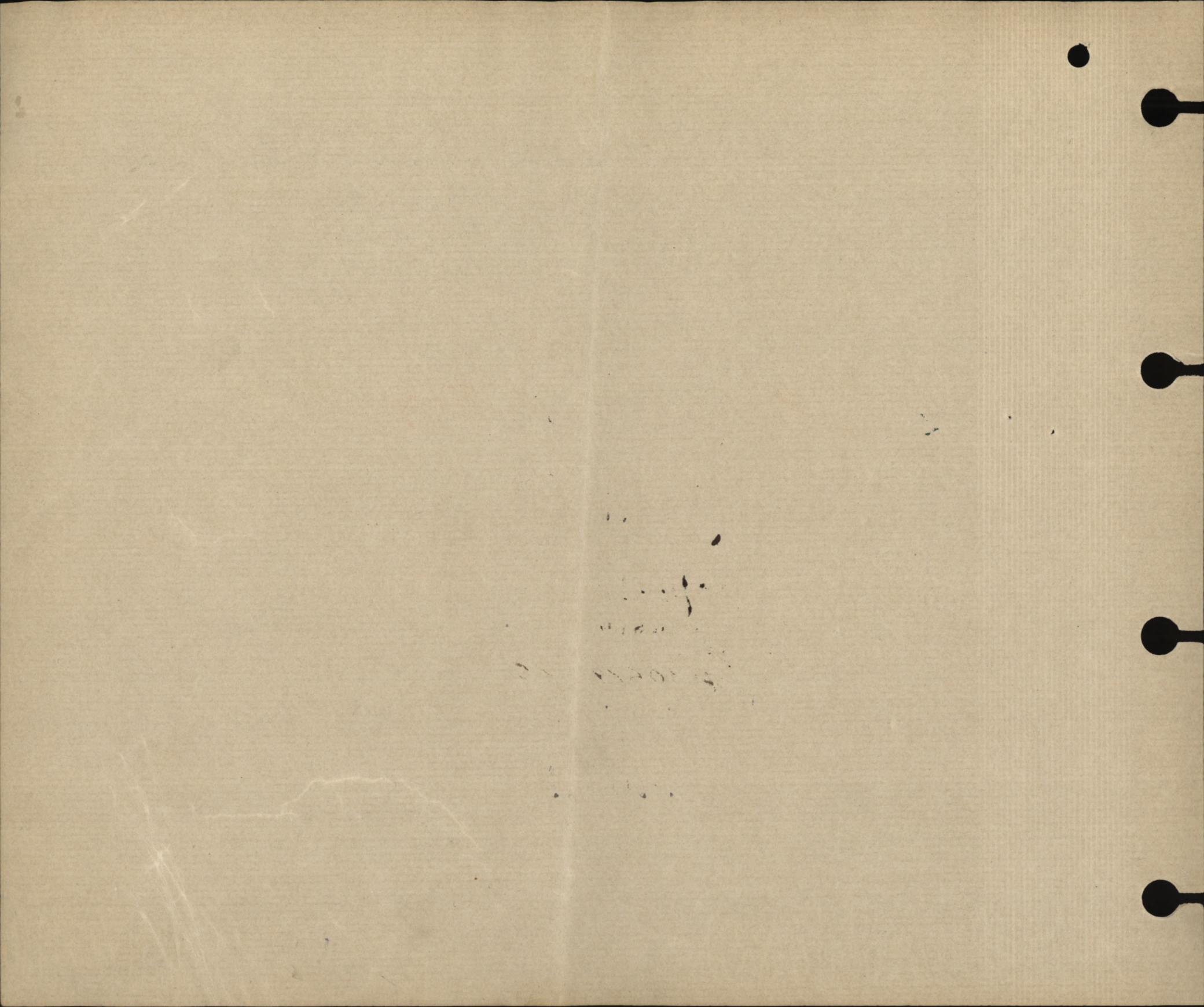

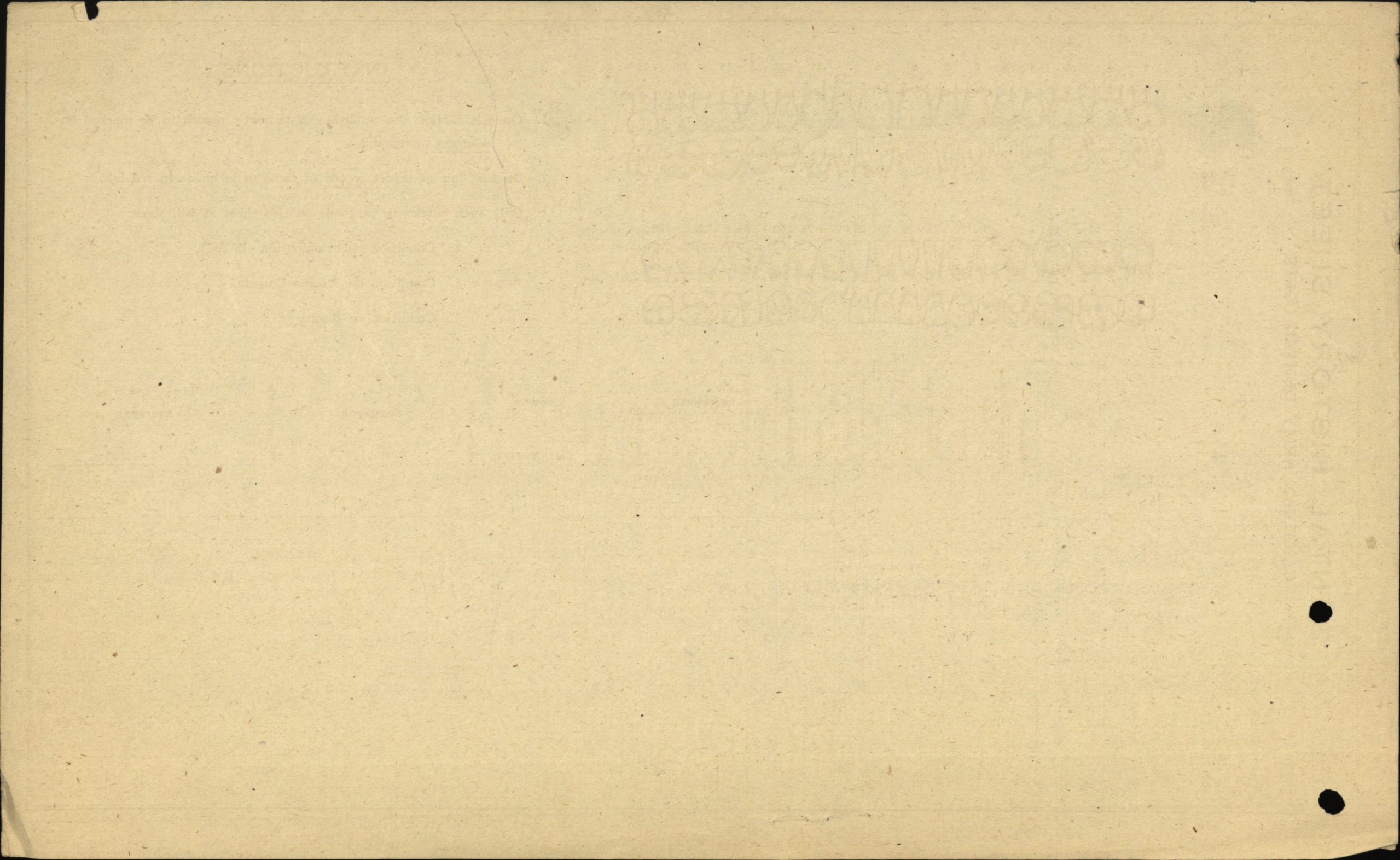

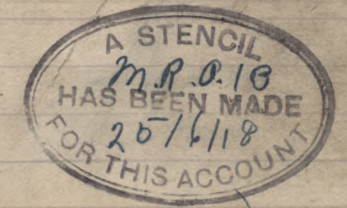
