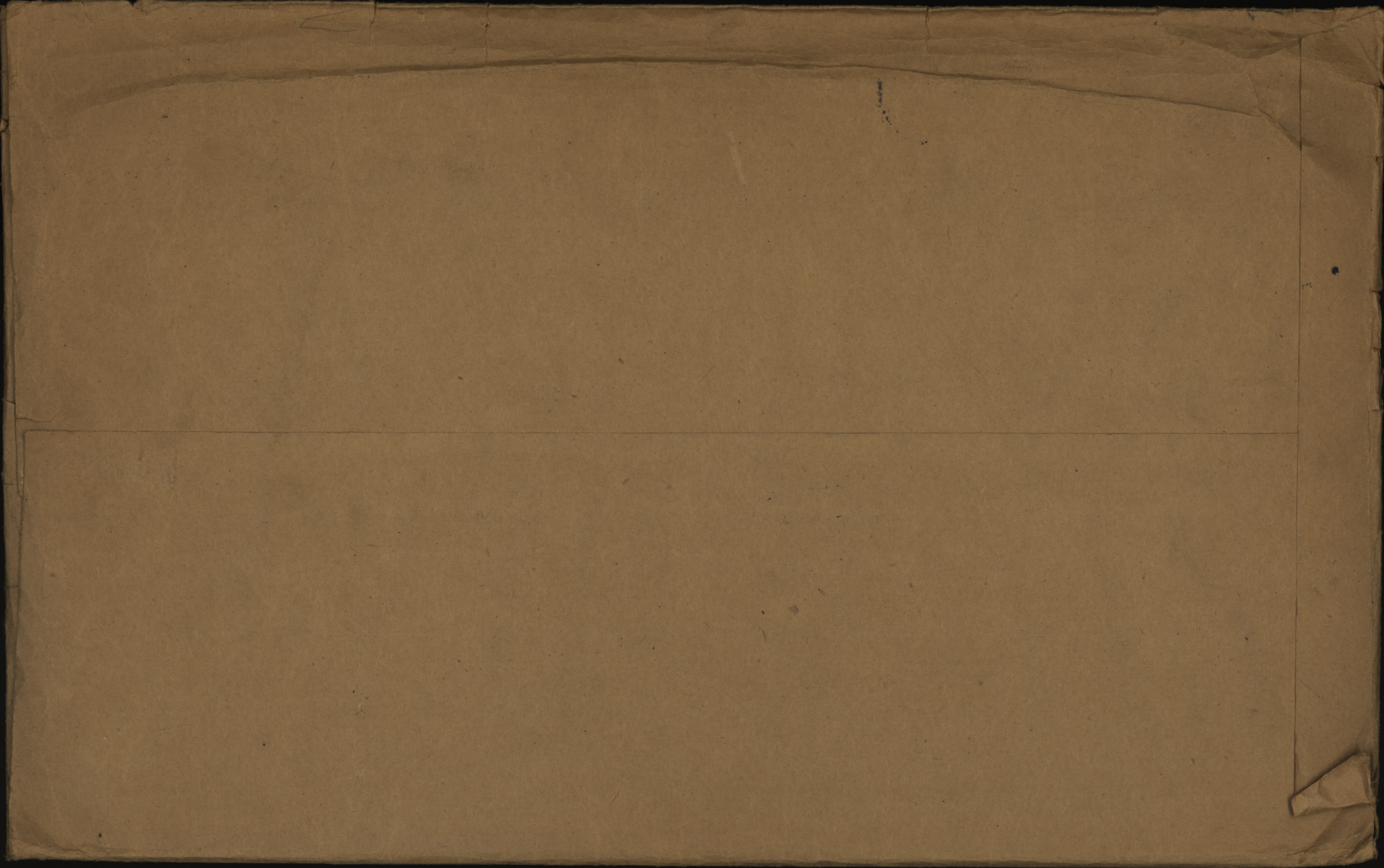





Stereoscopic plates were made of the chest, the bony outlines of which are apparently normal. The heart and arch of the aorta are also normal.

There is much infiltration of the entire bronchial tree throughout both sides, and in the right apex and right vertical bronchus there is considerable matting, and very marked fibrosis with numerous glands and calcified nodules. Elsewhere, however, the lung tissue is apparently clear.

The right lower bronchus is heavier than normal, and causes the hitching up of the diaphragm which is slightly adherent on this side.

There is not sufficient evidence to warrant a diagnose of a definitely tubercular condition.
