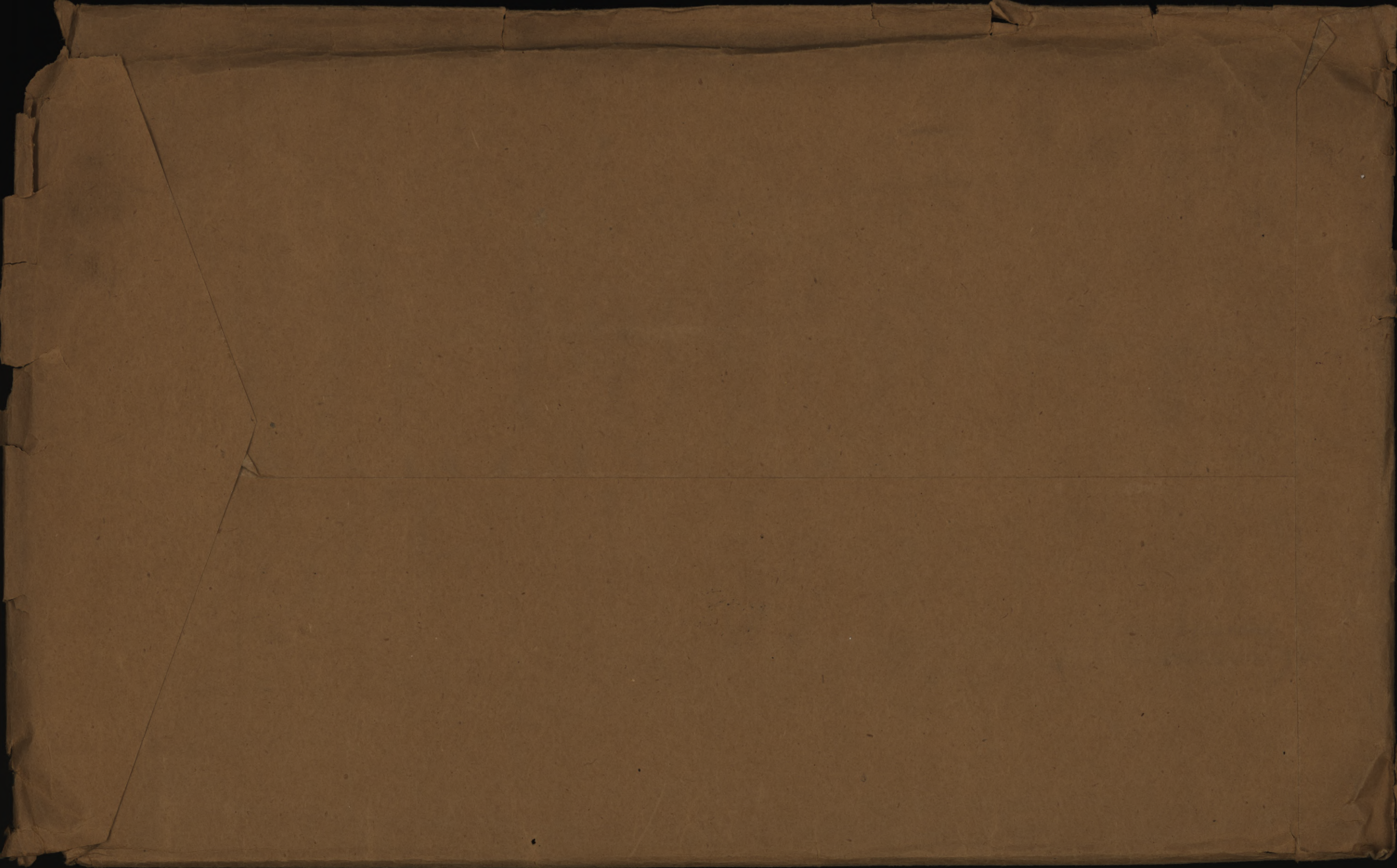

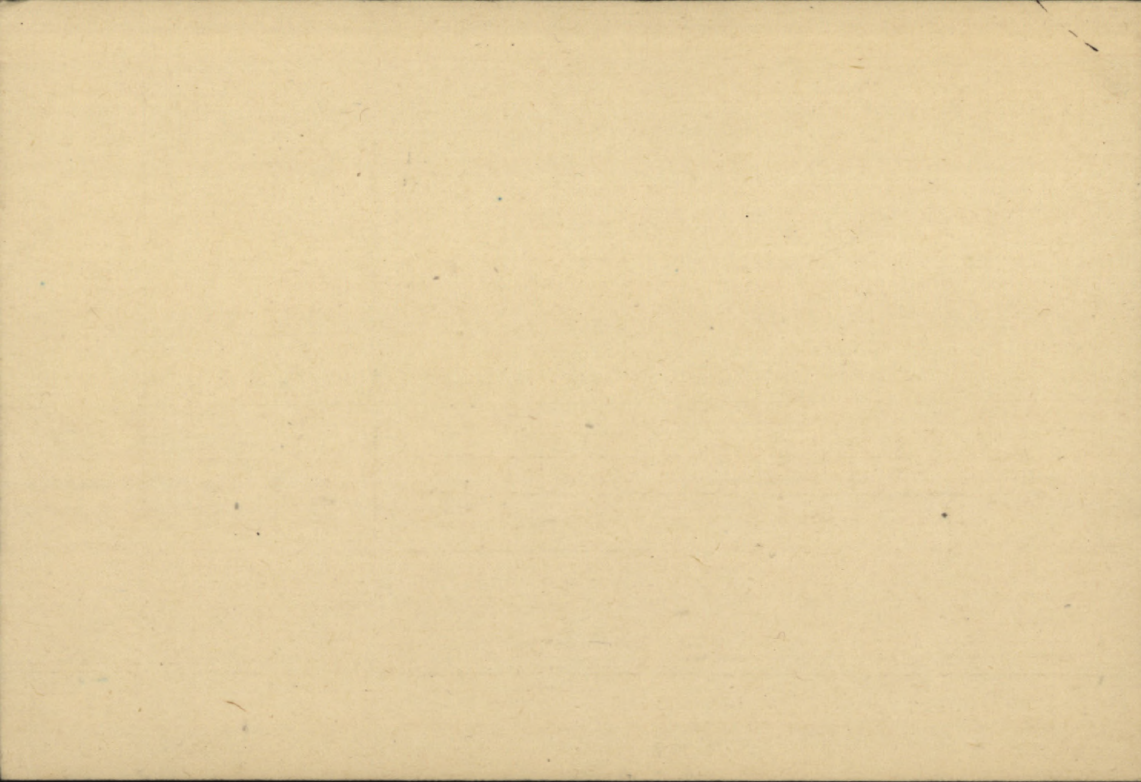

Extension to 170 degrees. Supination & pronation normal. Median nerve O.K. The fibres of ulnar nerve supplying the two inner tendons of flexor profundus have been injured as ring and little fingers can only be flexed 60% particularly the terminal phalanges. On pressure over dorsal & palmar surface hand, little & inner half ring fingers man says he feels "pins & needles" running through this area. Man can extend little finger. Grip about 75%. Hand is always blue & cold.
