The Medical Board, having assembled pursuant to order, proceed to examine Lieut. G.A. Gerald, and find that he is convalescing from Shrapnel wound of right forearm caused by the explosion of a German bomb, and some nervous symptoms due to the shell concussion.

Small scar about 1 inch long on outer aspect of elbow. He states that X-Ray taken in England shows three shrapnel fragments imbedded in forearm about the elbow, and one small fragment in lower third of forearm, outer surface. No loss of sensation, no numbness. Movements at elbow, wrist hand, and fingers all normal. Gripping power of hand lessened 25% (twenty-five per cent.) He says he cannot lift heavy objects with right hand on account of weakness in forearm.

Complaints of nervousness and excitability. Knee jerks moderately plus. Fine tremors present. Nervous in speech and manner.

Heart, lungs and other systems normal.

Permanently unfit for Overseas. Fit for light duty in Canada.

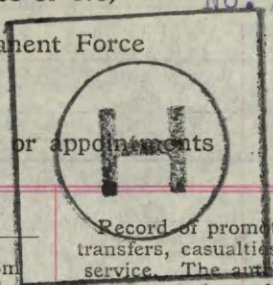

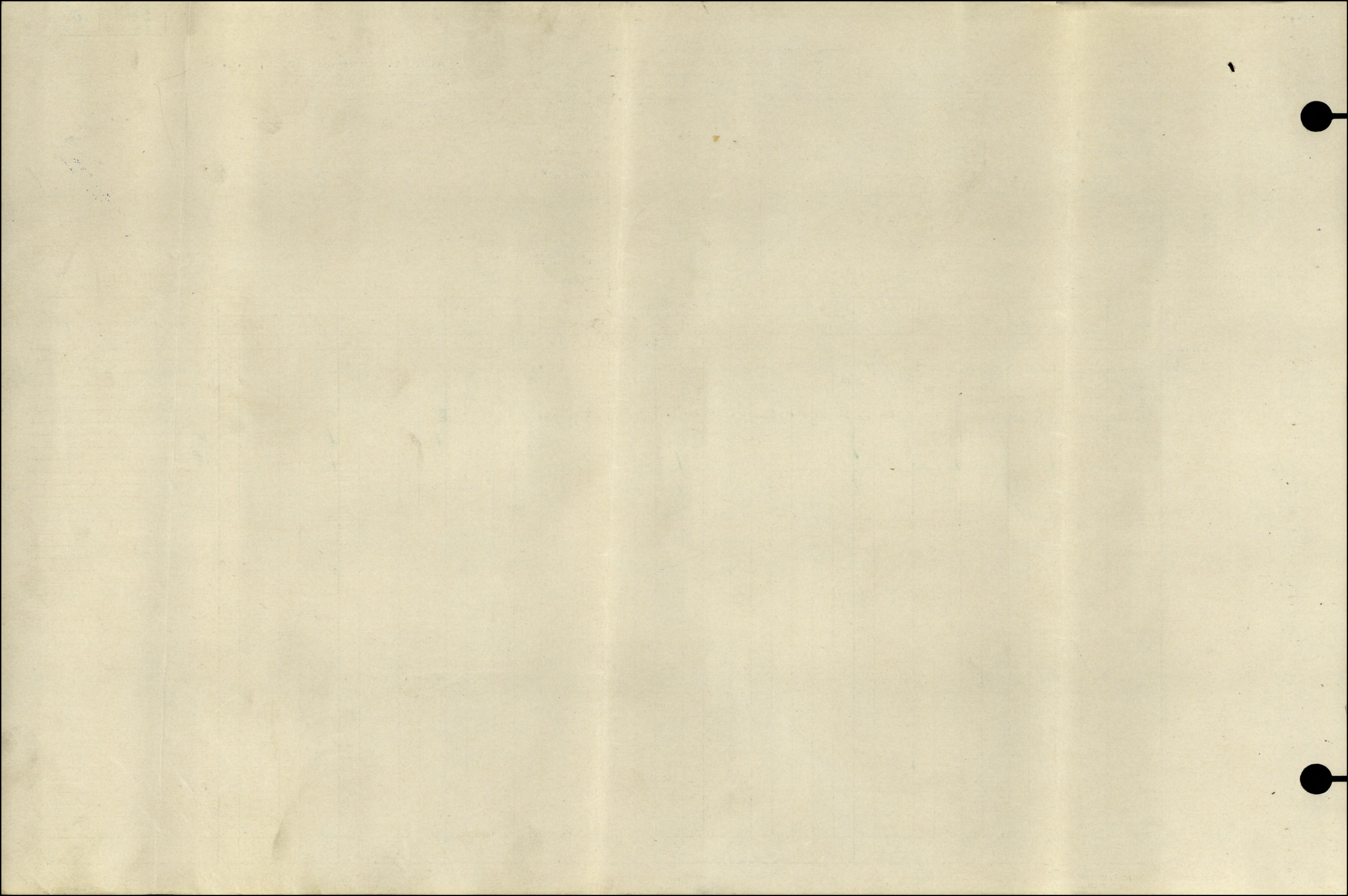

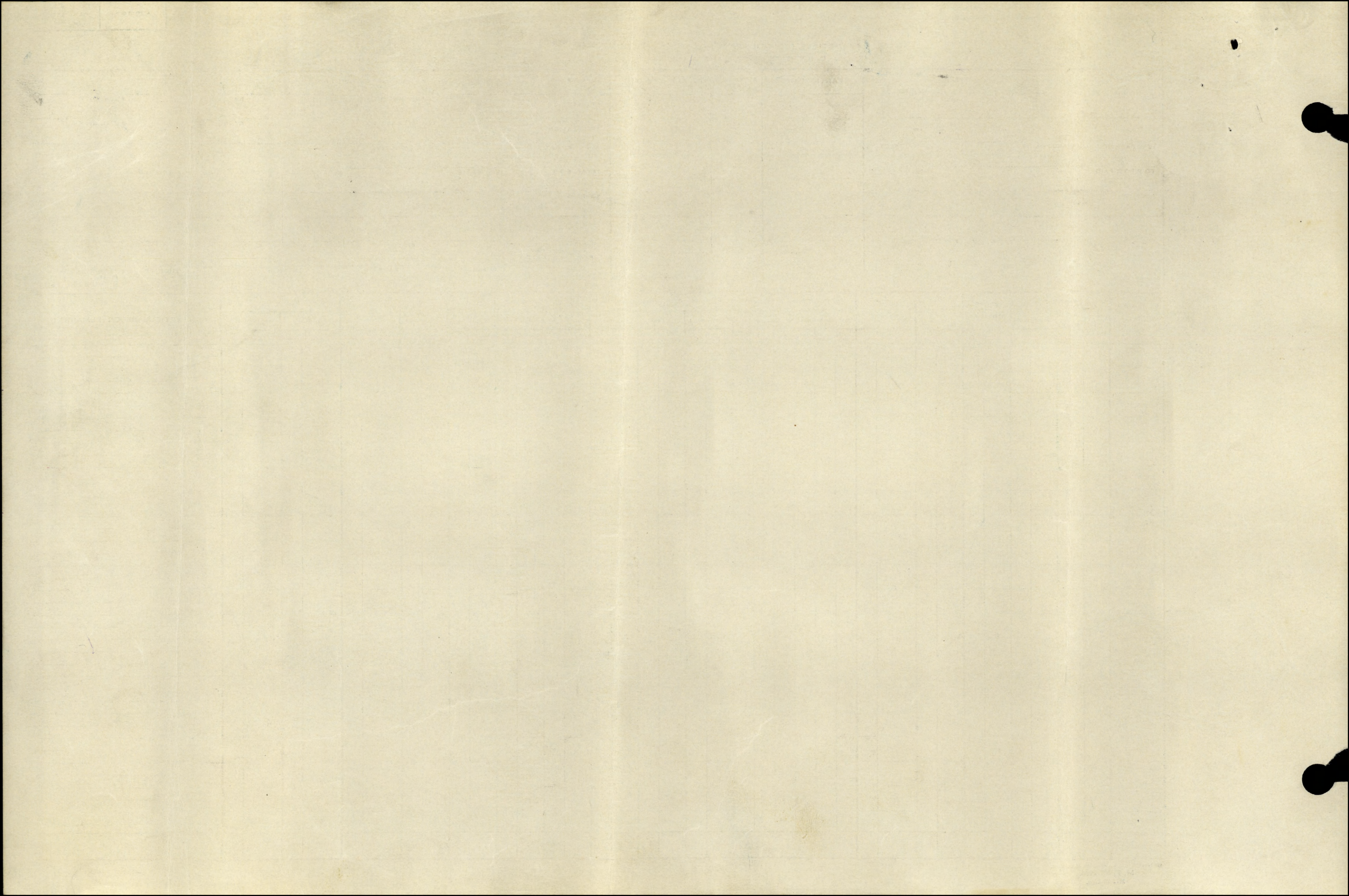
